

From email correspondence between the student and Lawrence Academy Trustee Bruce MacNeil, after comments were submitted to press, yet no response of any kind was offered to the student. Both Headmaster Dan Scheibe and Trustee Bruce MacNeil have remained *unavailable*...

I am, in fact, able to share my reasoning around the demands (reason-able). They are quite simple.

My reason for adding an additional resolution point was that I discovered a young man very close to current administration had been allowed (quite recently) to go on to sexually assault more young women, with zero safety check for anyone involved.

The reason I added this point is that people are trusting ME with their stories (curious, how is cooperation with alumni for your investigation going?). I have been holding numerous horrible stories of young people abused and then silenced at Lawrence Academy.

The reason I added this additional point is because I feel a moral obligation to take action to see that no further harm is suffered by young people on their path to a successful adult life...

You?

Remember also, this tactic of intimidating and mistreating me in hopes of getting me/my message to go away has not worked for you yet. Not in 1994, not in 2001, not now in 2018.

“Let’s do the right thing here” and
“Go away. We’re fine.”

is becoming an awfully old and worn-out conversation.

My invitation to a new kind of conversation (unscripted by attorneys, out from behind closed doors) remains open to you.

You know my goals:

1. bring the truth to light
2. hold school leaders to account
3. enact lasting, positive change

Do let me know if you find good reason to join me in this effort.
